**COVID-19 related connections** are those individuals seeking general information related to the coronavirus COVID-19, were interested in volunteer opportunities and/or indicated their need was impacted by COVID-19 (ex: employment, school, program closures, etc.).

**COVID-19 related-connections overtime:** On March 10th, the first coronavirus COVID-19 was confirmed in Michigan. On March 12, Governor Whitmer announces all Michigan K-12 schools will close starting Monday, March 16, through April 5. On March 13, Governor Whitmer bans gatherings of more than 250 people and President Trump declares national emergency. On March 15, Governor Whitmer bans gatherings with more than 50 people. On March 23, Governor Whitmer issues a statewide-stay-home order for all non-essential workers. Click the "Focus Mode" icon located on the upper right corner of the tables/graphs to expand.

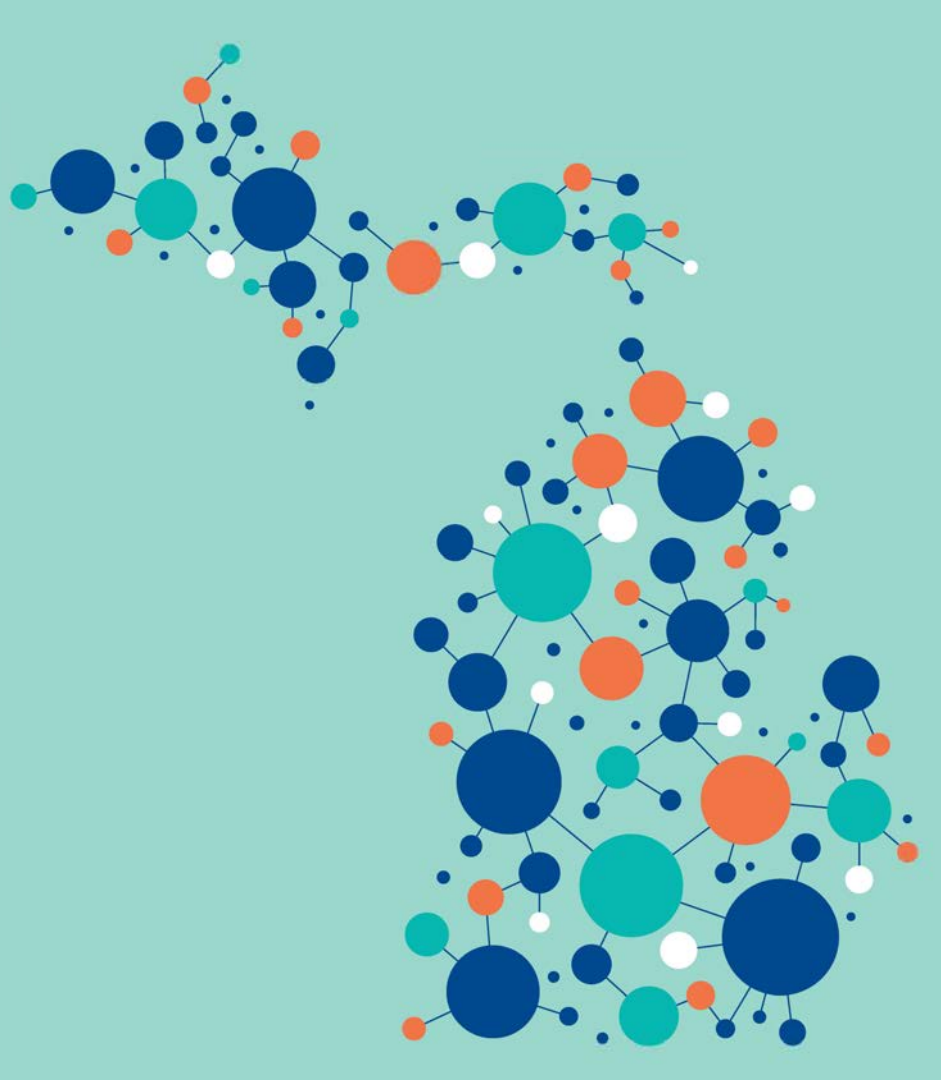
